Instructions for use

Spray a fine mist from approx. 20cm from surface to be treated. After a few seconds, polish with a microfiber cloth or soft duster. To prevent unwanted spray onto other surfaces, spray onto cloth/duster and apply as required, then polish with another cloth.

All non-porous hard surfaces, including plastic, wood not requiring a wax coating, imitation leather, all surfaces prone to dust needing a bright gloss finish, and many more.
